




















































Victoria Lines staircase discovered by Maltese climbers

In an effort to improve scores for rock disribers at the popular clisibling size of West 2-Glassei, members of the Melta Rock Clisibling Clab (MRCC) have reservity successed sections of a statecase that foreis part of the Victoria Lises defeosite wall. First the submorial accents of sail, segmatice acid screed durped from the sparry shows, this section of the neicase appears to have been bidden for reary decades, and its existence, was only noticed escidentally by the slab's Environment and Accent Officer Roland Bultana, during a menter climiting activity.







(MRCC) recently uncovered sections of a staircase which forms part of the Victoria Lines defensive wall along Wiel il-Glusel. major feat of engineering in its time, was built by the British colonial admin-istration between 1870 and 1899 as a first line of defence for the island. It crosses several valleys and descends steeply down the sides of these, posing a challenge to the original builders in a challenge to the original buildees in making it possible for solicities defend-ing the lines to travel tack and forth trapidly along the length of the Lines. To tackle this problem, great skill and ef-fort was dedicated to the placing of wide staircases, sometimes haven out of the rock of the valley sides, along the defensive wall in the parts where it fell served is into valley.

Registrably, the Victoria Lines are not very well preserved. According to MT Warrington however, "the voluntary of-forts of just 15 people in one day made a big difference to a small section of the well.
